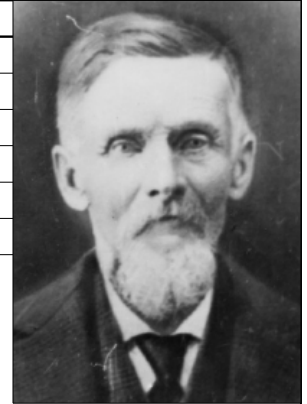

Know ye that the records of this office show that John Wilson was enrolled as a Private in Company G 162nd. Regiment, Ohio Vol. Infantry on the 2nd. day of May, 1864 at [blank], by [blank] and was mustered into the United States service as such for the period of 100 days, on the 20th. day of May, 1864 at Camp Chase, Ohio, by 1st. Lieutenant James P. W. Neill U.S.A. Mustering Officer, and that he was thirty nine years of age at the time of his enrollment in the Civil War. Mustered out with Company September 4, 1864.





- He was described as 5 ft. 7 in., light complexion, grey eyes, light hair on 2 May 1864 in Canton, Osaburg Twp., Stark County, Ohio.
- He immigrated from Osnaburg Twp., Stark County, Ohio in 1865 to Clay Twp., Kosciusko County, Indiana.

Wilson probably owned this land before 1869. This date is the first we find in a township valuation book. In the 1895 plat book it shows that John sold 20 acres to Samuel Snoke. When he died in 1903, his wife Susan inherited the land. When she died in 1920, the land went to Monroe Wilson, thier son. In 1895 the plat book lists the land as less the SW 1/2 acre. This was the site of a small one-room school house built in 1881. This schoolhouse still exists and can be rented for functions. This land was originally owned by Jonathan Willard, purchased 12 Oct 1836.
